

Becky's Billet Doux

For you were called to freedom, brothers and sisters; only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for self-indulgence, but through love become slaves to one another.

Galatians 5:13

CHRISTIAN FREEDOM

Steve Paulson in Luther for Armchair Theologians, says, "... Scripture's freedom has never been an isolated, individualistic, lonely, and ultimately deathdealing notion like the ones that capture our imaginations today. True freedom is being captivated

Christ's promise of forgiveness of sins." Johann Hamann describes the "the motif of freedom... By being set free from sin the human is again restored... to the freedom and responsibility granted with the creation." These views align with Luther's, "A Christian is a lord of all, completely free of everything. A Christian is a servant of all, completely attentive to the needs of all."

Christianity, as lived in this freedom, is not subject to rules and morality, but celebrated in

salvation and freedom in the Lord. Gerhard Forde declares, in Where God Meets Man, that the purpose of the church is to "preserve and protect the message of freedom, to help keep the possibility of faith and hope alive." The church's purpose, then, is not to prescribe behaviors or thoughts required for salvation. The Gospel does not point to man and what man must or must not do, but to what Jesus has already done. In the onceand-for-all sacrifice of Jesus Christ not only is a believer's identity made known, but freedom is realized. Forde illustrates this freedom in the following way. Consider a king who imposes strict laws on his subjects. The penalty for violating any law is death. Should this king give a "charter of freedom" to a person, the charter would resemble a law,

but, in actuality, be the exact opposite. "It is the gift of freedom." As Paulson says, "Faith means you are not just somewhat free but *perfectly* free." Being free does not entail being freed from *some* things but freed from everything and everyone. The sinner is now free to live a new life in this world, free to be helpful to the neighbor. This service is not merit-worthy or obligatory but, it is simply God working through people for the benefit of other people.

Freedom is granted by God alone. Freedom is the privilege to live in the world as creature, not abusing creation, nor fearing creation but enjoying life as creature within creation. This freedom is offered through the Word, the promise of God.
